

CLINICAL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES

During each semester, the following objectives must be accomplished. Deadlines will not be extended for any reason. The student is responsible for knowing the clinical areas he/she has been assigned within the semester. Clinical sign-off sheets must be reviewed by the Clinical Coordinator. There are a total of 6 clinical categories in the clinical educational program.

In order to be signed off for a particular competency in each of the Six Categories, the student must meet the standards outlined in the weekly evaluations:

- A. Patient
- B. Exam Performance
- C. Radiation Protection
- D. Image Analysis
- E. Critical Thinking
